In his obituary in the Association of Anaesthetics Journal (1951) Dr Moir was also described as 'no mean athlete. In his younger days he played both 'rugger' and 'soccer' and later held official positions in many athletics clubs'. Edward Moir is known to have been an official starter at Olympic and British Empire Games level as well as officiating in other capacities.
